

## PARTNERING TOGETHER

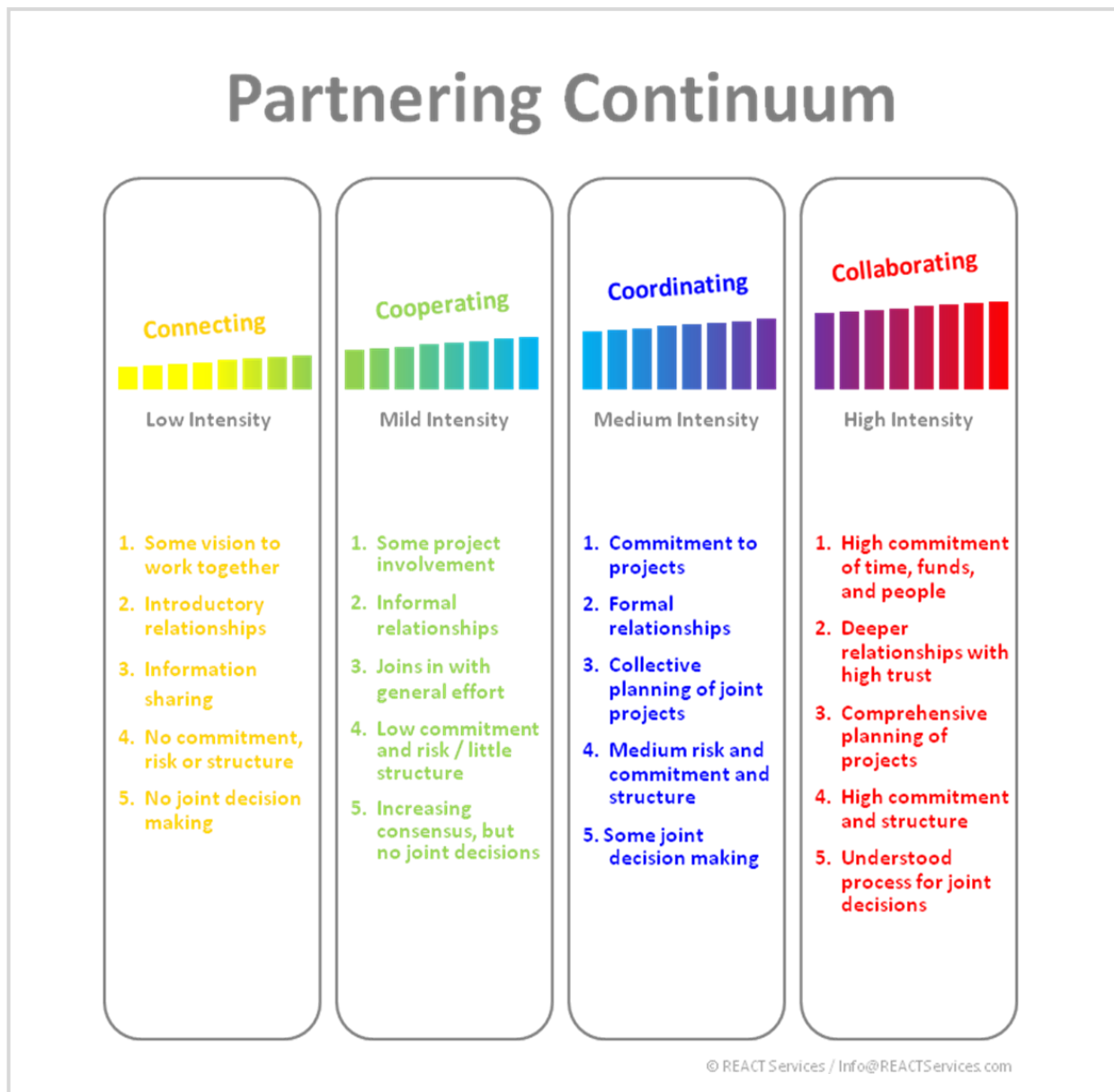

**CORE FOCUS OF GCF AND THE MAIN FOCUS OF THE 2009 PROGRAM**

These two areas are the core focus of GCF and the main reason for meeting globally. A large part of GCF is about "blue-sky" thinking, challenging the status quo and seeking God's wisdom for how to do ministry with children more effectively. The challenge of 1 billion children who have never heard the gospel is a key factor in the thinking of GCF.
